Amy continued with her training at Goodwill as she completed the Employment Essentials program and the Corporate Customer Service training. It was important to absorb everything she could and she certainly did that.

Amy also participated in a new endeavor with Goodwill Industries of Tulsa called Beyond Jobs for Women, supported by a national partnership with the WalMart Foundation and Goodwill Industries International. This program reaches women who are unemployed or underemployed to help them support their families. Through the Beyond Jobs program, which began in November 2012, women can access a complete career assessment, individualized career planning, and connections to employment opportunities, financial education and resources to help reach long-term goals and support to help advance their careers.

Goodwill Industries of Tulsa hosted a 'hiring event' for Home Depot and Amy was hired as Shipping and Receiving Clerk one month after starting with the Tulsa WORKS program. Amy worked at Home Depot in the evening while completing Goodwill classes during the day. She was elated! She was making more money, she had the responsibility she wanted and now, it was time to save her money. Amy states, "being a part of the Beyond Jobs Program helped me to begin saving my money." This was something she always wanted to do, but never took the time to develop a plan to do it well. The Beyond Jobs program helped her design a method of savings that matched her style. After completing the classes at Goodwill, Amy saved over \$200 dollars in one month and after approximately 6 months, she had \$2,000 dollars in savings.

Amy took the time to believe in herself, invest in herself, and she discovered just how important it is to do so. Amy still has that smile, she still has the determination to always continue to learn and grow. To everything there is a season. This is Amy's season!

New Southwest Boulevard Store to Open in May

fter 43 years and two previous expansions, Goodwill has outgrown the space available for Retail, Processing and Workforce Development Programs at our headquarters facility at 2800 Southwest Boulevard, In 2014 a



number of exciting changes are in the works to reconfigure our headquarters facility. The construction of a new retail store located two blocks south at 3110 Southwest Boulevard will allow for expansion of operations and workforce programs in our current location. Moving the retail store will also allow for a significant increase in available parking for employees, program participants, shoppers and visitors.

Construction of the new store began in November 2013 and a grand opening is planned for May. The store design will highlight our location on historic Route 66 and will be a fun stop for visitors from around the world who travel down the Southwest Boulevard leg of the Mother Road. The new store, like our current location, is visible from Highway 75. Visitors will be able to access the store by taking the Southwest Boulevard exit just north of the Goodwill headquarters.

Donations of gently used clothing and household items will continue to be accepted at the donation center at the south end of our 2800 Southwest

Boulevard facility. An attendant is on duty 24 hours each day at this location for the convenience of our donors.

The new store will open as spring and summer fashions fill our stores. 'Fun in the Sun' fashions, toys,



entertaining décor, beach reads, sandals and swimwear make Goodwill the perfect place to spark your summer wardrobe and to update your summer accessories for a fraction of department store prices. More and more shoppers are finding that it's 'Fun to be Frugal' when they discover Goodwill.
