

Emergency Shutdown Procedures Reminder

As fall turns into winter, now is a good time to familiarize yourself with our emergency shutdown procedure in the unlikely event of a weather-related schedule change. As written in the Employee Handbook (see Other Employment Policies, section VII: EMERGENCY SHUTDOWN, page 40), here's what happens in case of an emergency shutdown:

- In the event of an emergency shutdown of the main facility, Goodwill will post messages on Facebook and goodwilltulsa.org. A text message will be sent to those who have opted into Goodwill Tulsa's text messaging system. A voice message will be recorded on the automated telephone system - (918) 584-7291. Select the option number for Company Announcements.
- Emergency shutdowns at other locations will be decided by and announced by the VP or Director of those facilities. During emergency shutdowns, full-time non-exempt employees may choose to use available vacation or paid personal leave.


