If you live in a rental household in Tulsa County and someone in your household has been financially impacted by COVID-19, you may be eligible for assistance with your gas and electric bills before Dec. 31.

Caring Community Friends: Apply online www.caringcommunityfriends.org/ assistance If you don't have all the additional documentation required by this agency, try another agency.

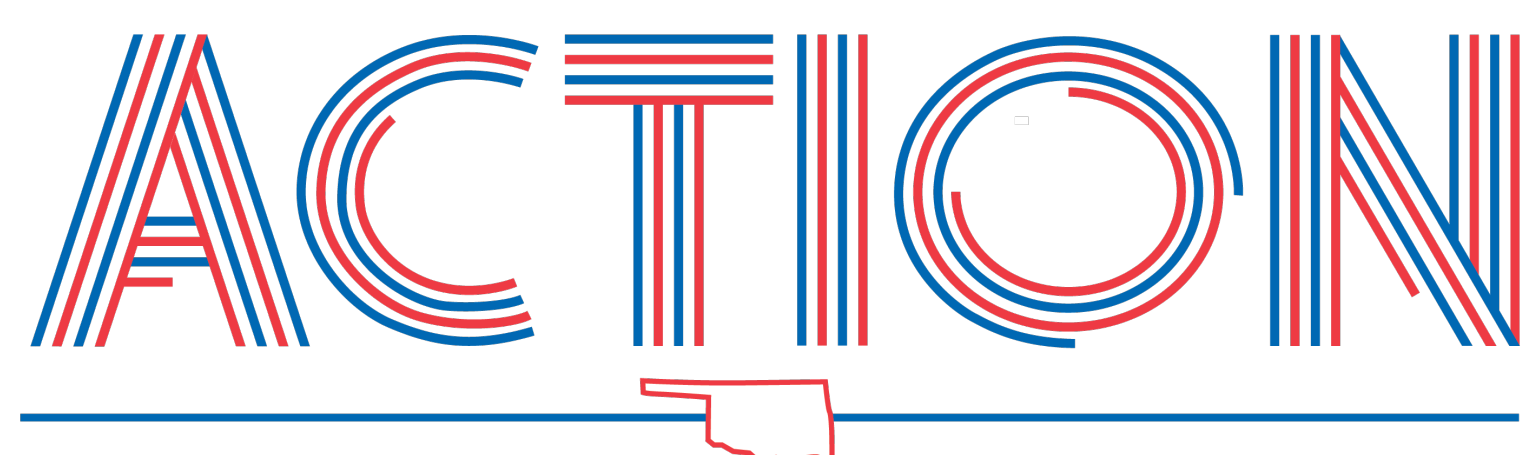
Catholic Charities: Email ehelp@cceok.org and a case manager will call you.
