EMPLOYEE SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS SUCCESSES, OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH

Thanks to all of you who completed the 2023 Employee Engagement Survey. We had 507 employees who responded, from executive to part-time staff, from brand new employees to individuals who have been with Goodwill for a decade or more, from all over the organization in terms of department/geography.

I was very happy to see high scores on two particular questions:

- Nearly 86 percent of employees said that someone at work seems to care about them as a person. This answer is gratifying, because it is emblematic of the kind of culture we want to be.
- Seventy-nine percent of employees say they have the opportunity to do what they do best every day at work. This answer tells me we are doing a pretty good job at what management expert Jim Collins referred to as putting the right people in the right seats on the bus —hiring people into the right jobs and letting them do what they do well.

Of course, we also have places where we can improve. Survey answers revealed some common employee challenges at Goodwill Tulsa. The good news is that we already had—or now have—plans to address these challenges. In particular:

• Challenge #1: Communication

Survey results indicate that we aren't doing as good a job as we could be at communicating, whether that means receiving feedback on your progress, receiving recognition for your work, or finding out Goodwill Tulsa news. Several efforts are in the works to improve communication:

- We are revamping our performance review system to ensure you receive regular feedback.
- We're overhauling our process for using text messages to help ensure that employees have access to timely information.
- Our Spectrum Leadership Training will train supervisors at all levels to communicate better the "why" of processes and decisions, not just the "what."
- A short survey will be released soon to ask what you want to hear about in the Grapevine and how you would prefer to receive it.

• Challenge #2: Training

Training came up repeatedly as an area for improvement. While most employees feel they have had the chance to learn and grow in the past year, responses were less positive about Goodwill as a good place to develop your career.

- Our new Grow with Goodwill program, launched in early July after months of visioning and planning, is designed to help employees build career paths at Goodwill or outside the organization.
- We've launched Spectrum Leadership Training, with the goal of helping Goodwill Tulsa's leaders improve their skills and grow in their roles.

These two programs will serve Goodwill Tulsa and our employees as they build their careers, whether they ultimately decide to build their professional lives at Goodwill or go elsewhere.

One more important note: By now many of you have met or heard from Myranda Freeman, our new Engagement Specialist. Myranda is designing a broad employee engagement strategy focused on events and activities that recognize employees for good work and ensure they feel connected to Goodwill Tulsa and its mission.
